



## Heimburger-Robinson Scholarship

The Brehm Center is now accepting applications for the Heimburger-Robinson Scholarship to be awarded for Fall 2010 to an incoming Music and Ministry student. The Heimburger-Robinson Scholarship is specifically for new students applying to the Music and Ministry focus established by the Fred Bock Institute of Music under the Worship, Theology, and the Arts emphasis. Applicants can either be enrolled in the Master of Divinity or Master of Arts in Theology and Ministry degrees.

### Scholarship History and Purpose

In 2008, a scholarship was established through the generous gift of Barbary and Roy Heimburger. The Heimburger-Robinson Scholarship was founded to honor the memory of their dear friend Fred Bock. It is designed to provide scholarship assistance to Master of Arts in Theology and Ministry and Master of Divinity candidates enrolled in authorized Music and Ministry curricula developed by the Fred Bock Institute of Music in partnership with Fuller Theological Seminary and the Brehm Center for Worship, Theology, and the Arts. Candidates for this scholarship will show exceptional promise for full-time church, academic, missions or arts related vocations. Furthermore, the scholarship is designed to encourage and invest in leaders who will be actively engaged in the revitalization of worship in the Church through practice and conversation, and who will contribute to the research on the role of worship and the arts in life, thought, and the community.

### Award Amount

The Heimburger-Robinson Scholarship provides half tuition and standard enrollment fees (including parking but excluding insurance) each term for the normal years of study. The scholarship will be renewed each year until the degree is completed (or until tuition is no longer needed), as long as the scholar remains in good standing and funds are available. If there is an outstanding candidate with greater financial need, the selection committee will have the discretion to award a larger percentage of tuition, up to and including full tuition.

### Eligibility Requirements:

- Be accepted as a new student into the Master of Divinity or Master of Arts in Theology and Ministry degree program for Summer or Fall 2010 by **April 23, 2010**.
- Enroll as a full-time (12 units per quarter) student at the Pasadena Campus
- Enroll in the Music and Ministry focus under the Worship, Theology, and the Arts emphasis (MATM or MDiv) approved by the Brehm Center Academic Director
- Demonstrate academic excellence
- Demonstrate musical talent and ability
- Demonstrate mature commitment to Jesus Christ
- Demonstrate financial need

## Heimbürger-Robinson Scholarship

### Selection Process:

Heimbürger-Robinson Scholars are selected by a committee chosen by the Executive and Academic Directors of the Brehm Center for Worship, Theology, and the Arts, in collaboration with the Office of Student Financial Services.

### Application Process:

1. Applicants must submit the attached Heimbürger-Robinson Scholarship Application and three letters of reference, including one from a person with knowledge of their demonstrated leadership and music ability.
2. Applicants must have a completed 2010-11 Fuller Financial Aid Application on file, available from the Financial Aid website: [www.fuller.edu/finaid](http://www.fuller.edu/finaid). U.S. citizens and permanent residents must also complete a 2010-11 FAFSA form at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov).
3. Applicants must also take a music theory test. The test is available online at: <http://www.brehmcenter.com/mediafiles/music-theory-entrance-exam.pdf>
4. Submit audition material. You may choose to arrange a live audition on the Pasadena campus or mail your audition material in the form of a CD or DVD. The audition material should include at least two pieces of music that you feel best showcase your musical gifts.
