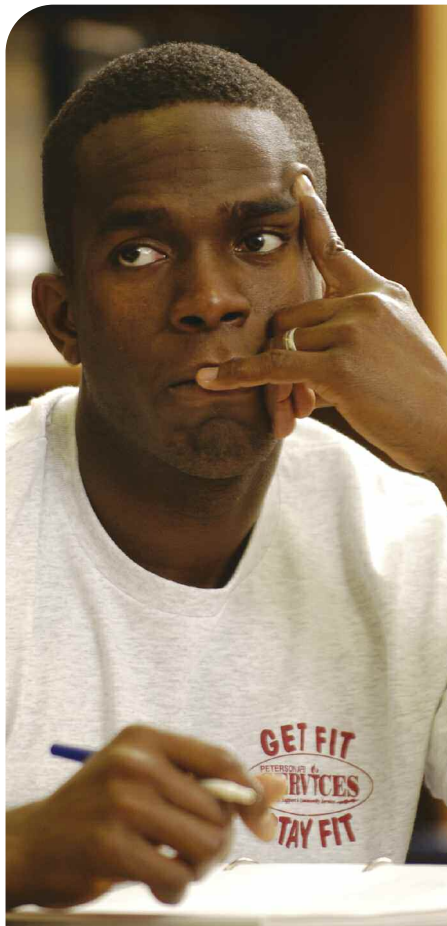

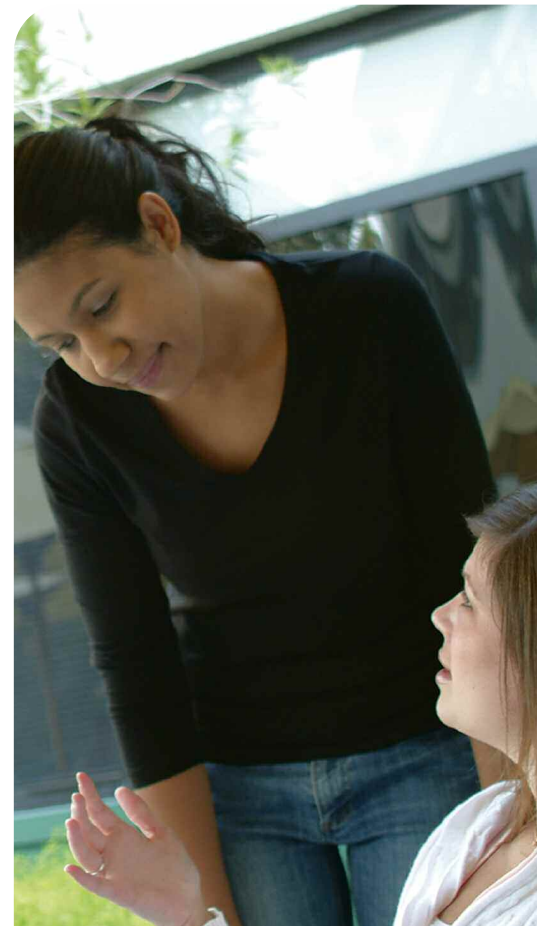

- Modeling growth in intellect, character, spirit, mission, and ministry.



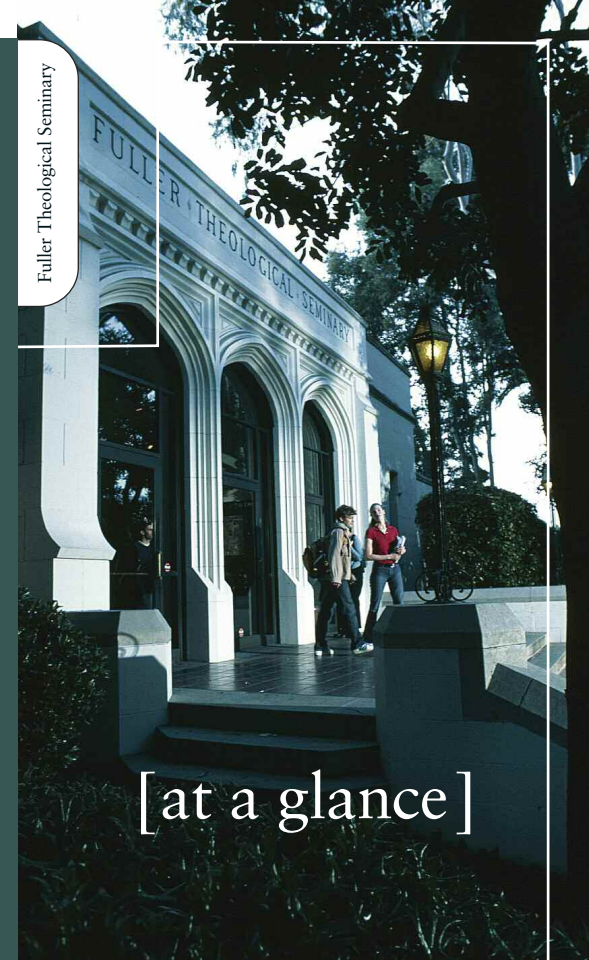

- Fuller's faculty are among the world's most published and influential seminary scholars, and are frequently quoted by U.S. and international media.

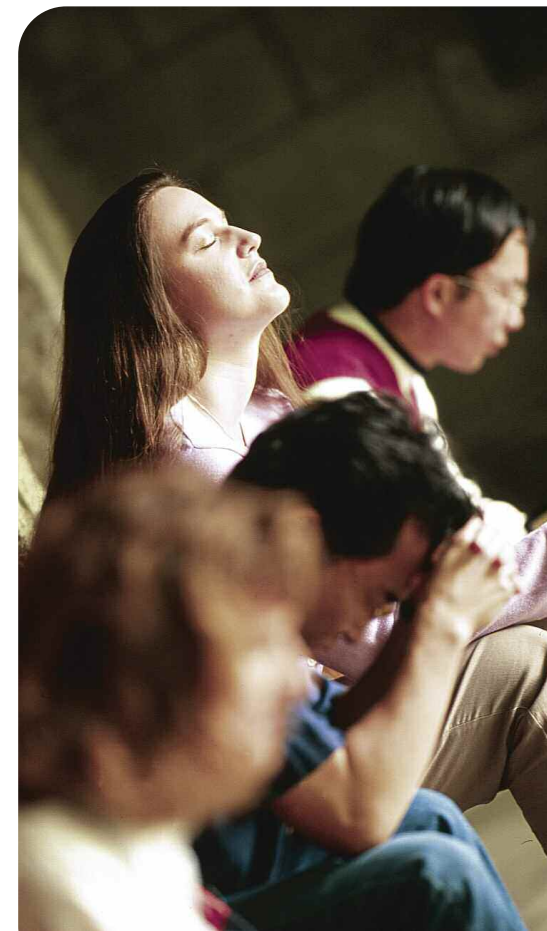
INFLUENTIAL ALUMNI/AE
