For 2008-2009, the percentage of attrition excluding inter-program transfers is 12%. The 20% noted above includes 2 students who switched to the PsyD program. The year of first enrollment included 6 who transferred from the PsyD program, for a cohort size of 23.

For 2009-2010, the percentage of attrition excluding inter-program transfers is 8%. The 13% noted above includes 1 student who switched to the PsyD program. The year of first enrollment includes 2 who transferred from the PsyD program, for a cohort size of 23.

For 2010-2011, the percentage of attrition excluding inter-program transfers is 16%. The 24% noted above includes 2 students who switched to the PsyD Program. The year of first enrollment includes 8 who transferred from the PsyD program, for a cohort size of 23.

For 2011-2012, the year of first enrollment includes 8 who transferred from the PsyD program.

For 2012-2013, the percent of attrition excluding inter-program transfers is 11%. The 14% noted above includes 1 student who switched to the non-clinical PhD program.

For 2013-2014, the percent of attrition excluding inter-program transfers is 11%. The 16% noted above includes 1 student who switched to the non-clinical PhD program. The year of first enrollment includes 1 who transferred from the PsyD program, for a cohort size of 18.

For 2014-2015, the year of first enrollment includes 2 who transferred from the PsyD program.

For 2015-2016, the percent of attrition excluding inter-program transfers is 16%. The 21% noted above includes 1 student who switched to the non-clinical PhD program.

For 2016-2017, the year of first enrollment includes 1 who transferred from the PsyD program.
