

Doctor of Missiology Preparatory Status

The DMiss Preparatory Status enables applicants who hold a master's degree to apply and have their application reviewed, provided the applicant meets a minimum 12 of the 36-units of prerequisite graduate-level coursework required for direct DMiss admission. The Admissions Committee will make recommendations on the remaining outstanding prerequisites in missiology and/or theology, which the applicant is welcome to take at Fuller or any other accredited institution. Under this status, applicants are afforded the knowledge of future acceptance to a DMiss cohort pending their successful completion of outstanding prerequisite master's-level coursework within one year, with a grade point average of 3.4 or higher. Once this is confirmed, the student's status is changed to a regular admission and the student may begin the program with an upcoming cohort. Failure to successfully complete the prerequisite coursework as stipulated would result in the revocation of your conditional admission to the DMiss program.
