Doctor of Ministry

Program Design: 4-5-year program

Students select either the Cohort <u>or</u> the Personalized Track. Coursework take approximately three years and the doctoral project two years.

- 1. **Cohort Track**: Focused study in a specific area of ministry, supervised by the same professor and cohort for the duration for the coursework phase OR
- 2. **Personalized Track (PT)**: Flexible and customizable. Students select electives from the PT Course Schedule.

AND

- 3. Doctoral Project Phase: 8 units
 - 120-page Doctoral Project
 - Project takes approximately two years to complete.

Program Outline

Intensive Seminar Classes: 1-2 weeks per year

- Pre-seminar reading (by first day of class):
 - o 12-unit: 4,500 pages by the first day of class, 40-50 pg
 - 8-unit: 3,000 pages by the first day of class, 30-40 pg
 - o 4-unit: 2,000 pages by the first day of class, 20-30 pg
- Post-seminar writing assignments due four months after seminar
 - o 12-unit: 40-50 page assignment
 - o 8-unit: 30-40 page assignment
 - o 4-unit: 20-30 page assignment
