For 2011-2012, the year of first enrollment includes 8 who transferred from the PsyD program.

For 2012-2013, the percent of attrition excluding inter-program transfers is 14%. The 18% noted above includes 1 student who switched to the non-clinical PhD program.

For 2013-2014, the percent of attrition excluding inter-program transfers is 21%. The 26% noted above includes 1 student who switched to the non-clinical PhD program. The year of first enrollment includes 1 who transferred from the PsyD program, for a cohort size of 18.

For 2014-2015, the year of first enrollment includes 2 who transferred from the PsyD program.

For 2015-2016, the percent of attrition excluding inter-program transfers is 16%. The 21% noted above includes 1 student who switched to the non-clinical PhD program.

For 2016-2017, the year of first enrollment includes 1 who transferred from the PsyD program.

For 2018-2019, the percent of attrition excluding inter-program transfers is 17%. The 25% noted above includes 1 student who switched to the PsyD program.

For 2020-2021, the year of first enrollment includes 1 who transferred from the PsyD program.
