For 2011-2012, the percentage of attrition excluding inter-program transfers is 20%. The 45% noted above includes 5 students who switched to the PhD Program. The year of first enrollment includes 2 who transferred from the PhD program, for a cohort size of 15.

For 2012-2013, the percentage of attrition excluding inter-program transfers is 15%. The 38% noted above includes 3 students who switched to the PhD Program. The year of first enrollment includes 2 who transferred from the PhD program, for a cohort size of 10.

For 2013-2014, the percentage of attrition excluding inter-program transfers is 12%. The 18% noted above includes 1 student who switched to the PhD Program. The year of first enrollment includes 1 who transferred from the PhD program, for a cohort size of 16.

For 2018-2019, the percentage of attrition excluding inter-program transfers is 9%. The 18% noted above includes 1 student who switched to the PhD Program.
