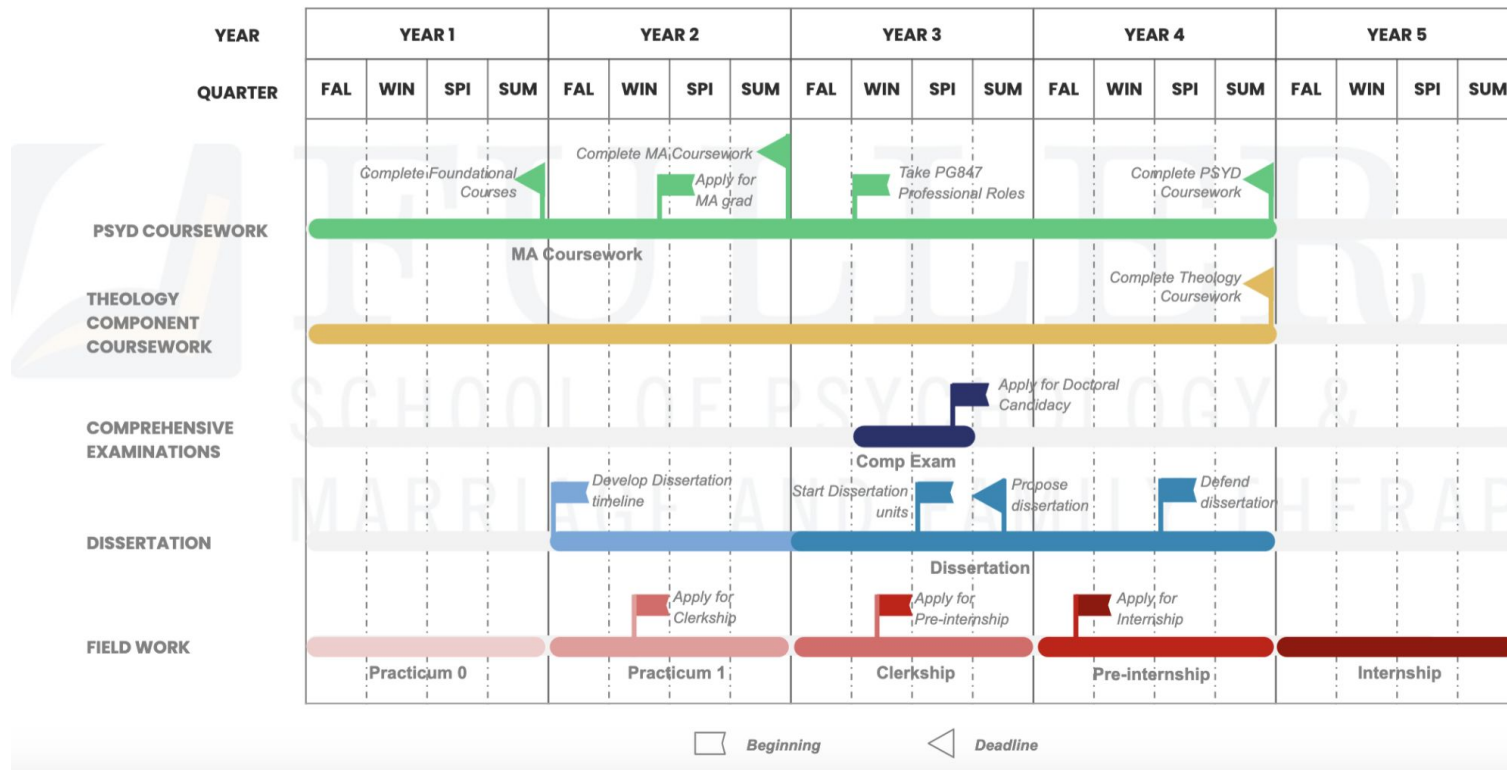

## SOPMFT PsyD Timeline



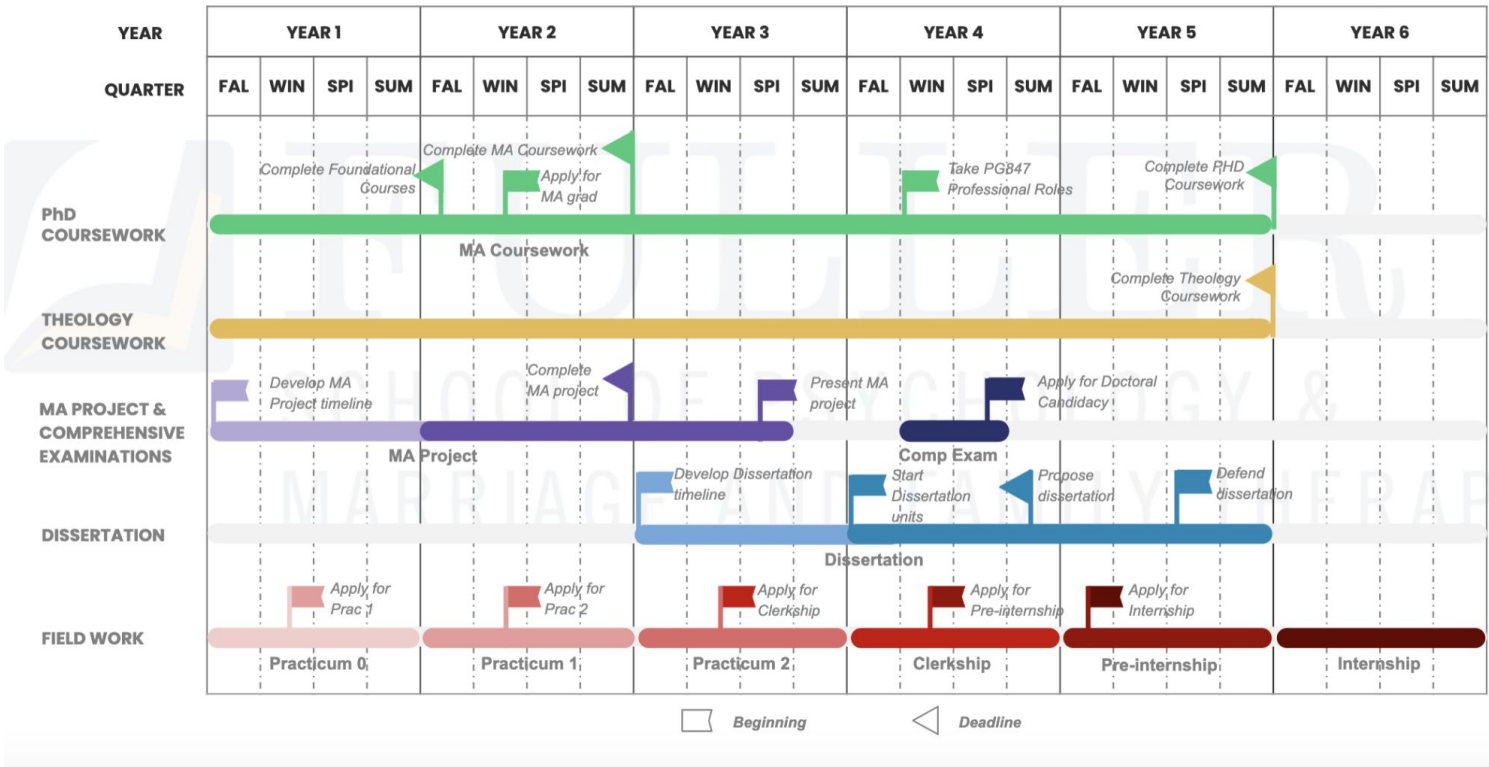

## **Culture & Community Track**

*Emphasizes in-depth coursework, cultural training experiences, and research opportunities addressing particular ethnocultural and community groups.*

# Financial Aid Overview

## Scholarship

- **PsyD or PhD Annual Scholarship**

### **Who can receive this scholarship?**

This scholarship is offered on a first come, first served basis for students admitted to a degree program within the School of Psychology & Marriage and Family Therapy. Students who plan to take at least 6 units per quarter for the upcoming 2021-2022 Academic Year are eligible for this scholarship.

### **How much does this scholarship cover?**

Students enrolled in 6-8 units per quarter will receive \$800 per quarter in aid; Students enrolled in 9-11 units per quarter will receive \$1,200 per quarter in aid; Students enrolled in 12-16 units per quarter will receive \$1,600 per quarter in aid.

This scholarship will be valid for the duration of the program prior to pre-doctoral internship, as long as students maintain the terms of eligibility.

### **Are there any other eligibility requirements?\***

Yes! In order to be eligible for this scholarship, you must:

- Be newly admitted to the Fuller PsyD or PhD in Clinical Psychology program in the upcoming 2022/2022 Academic Year.
- Must continue to meet eligibility criteria listed in scholarship terms and conditions.

# Financial Aid Overview

## Scholarships

- **Robertson Scholarship**

**Who can receive this scholarship?**

Students admitted to the PsyD or PhD in Clinical Psychology program for the upcoming Fall 2022 Quarter are eligible to receive this scholarship.

**How much does this scholarship cover?**

This scholarship will be awarded by faculty vote to three highly qualified students who will receive \$15,000 per year for three years, and will be valid as long as students maintain the terms of eligibility.

- **Are there any other eligibility requirements?\***

Yes! In order to be eligible for this scholarship, you must:

- Be newly admitted to the Fuller PsyD or PhD degree program
- Maintain active participation in a research lab
- Maintain at least half-time enrollment from fall-spring quarter(s)

# Financial Aid Overview

## Scholarship

- **Underserved Scholarship**

### **Who can receive this scholarship?**

Students coming from a historically underserved community who are admitted to the PsyD or PhD in Clinical Psychology program for the upcoming Fall 2022 Quarter are automatically considered for this scholarship.

### **How much does this scholarship cover?**

This scholarship will be awarded by faculty vote to two newly accepted students who will receive \$5,000 for the first year in their program, and will be valid during the course of that year as long as students maintain the terms of eligibility.

### **Are there any other eligibility requirements?\***

Yes! In order to be eligible for this scholarship, you must:

- Be newly admitted to the Fuller PsyD or PhD in Clinical Psychology degree program
- Maintain at least half-time enrollment from fall-spring quarter(s)

*\*Scholarship selection is determined by vote of the faculty and is based upon prior academic history, test scores (PhD), interviews, and recommendation of the PsyD or PhD Admissions Committee.*
