

Program Scholarships Available for the 2022-2023 Academic Year

Master of Divinity (MDiv) Scholarship

Who can receive this scholarship?

Students admitted to the MDiv degree program for the upcoming 2022-2023 Academic Year who plan to take at least 8 units per quarter are eligible for this scholarship.

Are there any other eligibility requirements?*

Yes! In order to be eligible for this scholarship, you must also:

- o Be newly admitted to the Fuller MDiv degree program.
- o Maintain a minimum cumulative Fuller GPA of 2.50 to remain eligible

MA in Theology (MAT) Scholarship

Who can receive this scholarship?

Students admitted to the MAT degree program for the upcoming 2022-2023 Academic Year who plan to take at least 8 units per quarter are eligible for this scholarship.

Are there any other eligibility requirements?*

Yes! In order to be eligible for this scholarship, you must also:

- Be newly admitted to the Fuller MAT degree program.
- Maintain a minimum cumulative Fuller GPA of 2.50 to remain eligible

MA in Justice and Advocacy (MJA)

^{*} New MDiv students who enroll in AY22/23 are eligible to receive scholarship support if they apply for and receive the MDiv Scholarship and if they meet and maintain the MDiv Scholarship criteria outlined. New MDiv students may only receive one institutional scholarship or discount from Fuller in a quarter, except in the case when they are also eligible for, apply to, and are awarded an endowed scholarship. Examples of endowed scholarships include the Texas Fellowship.

Examples of endowed scholarships include the Texas Fellowship.

Who can receive this scholarship?

Students admitted to the MJA program for the upcoming Fall 2022 cohort.

Are there any other eligibility requirements?*

Yes! In order to be eligible for this scholarship, you must also:

- Be newly admitted to the Fuller MJA degree program.
- Must enroll in 8 units in Fall, Winter, and Spring Quarters each year for two consecutive years.
- Maintain a minimum cumulative Fuller GPA of 2.50 to remain eligible

MA in Intercultural Studies (MAICS)

Who can receive this scholarship?

Students admitted to the MAICS program for the upcoming 2022-2023 Academic Year who plan to take at least 8 units per quarter are eligible for this scholarship.

Are there any other eligibility requirements?*

Yes! In order to be eligible for this scholarship, you must also:

- o Be newly admitted to the Fuller MAICS degree program.
- Maintain a minimum cumulative Fuller GPA of 2.50 to remain eligible

Centro Latino Scholarship (Beca Centro Latino)

MA in Theology and Ministry (MATM)

Who can receive this scholarship?

Students admitted to the MATM degree program for the upcoming 2022-2023 Academic Year are eligible for this scholarship.

New MAICS students may only receive one institutional scholarship or discount from Fuller in a quarter, except in the case when they are also eligible for, apply to, and are awarded an endowed scholarship.

- Maintain a minimum cumulative Fuller GPA of 2.50 to remain eligible

Doctor of Global Leadership (DGL)

Who can receive this scholarship?

Students admitted to the DGL degree program for the upcoming 2022-2023 Academic Year are eligible for this scholarship.

Are there any other eligibility requirements?*

Yes! In order to be eligible for this scholarship, you must also:

- Be newly admitted to the Fuller DGL degree program.
- Maintain a minimum cumulative Fuller GPA of 3.0 to remain eligible

MS in Marriage and Family Therapy (MSMFT)

Who can receive this scholarship?

Students admitted to the MSMFT degree program for the upcoming 2022-2023 Academic Year who plan to take at least 8 units per quarter are eligible for this scholarship.

Are there any other eligibility requirements?*

Yes! In order to be eligible for this scholarship, you must also:

- Be newly admitted to the Fuller MSMFT degree program.
- o Maintain a minimum cumulative Fuller GPA of 3.0 to remain eligible

^{*} New MATM students who enroll in AY22/23 are eligible to receive scholarship support if they apply for and receive the MATM Scholarship and if they meet and maintain the MATM Scholarship criteria outlined. New MATM students may only receive one institutional scholarship or discount from Fuller in a quarter, except in the case when they are also eligible for, apply to, and are awarded an endowed scholarship. Examples of endowed scholarships include the Texas Fellowship.

^{*} New DGL students who enroll in AY22/23 are eligible to receive scholarship support if they apply for and receive the DGL Scholarship and if they meet and maintain the DGL Scholarship criteria outlined. Doctor of Marriage and Family Therapy (DMFT)

Who can receive this scholarship?

Students admitted to the DMFT program for the upcoming 2022-2023 Academic Year who plan to take at least 4 units per quarter are eligible for this scholarship.

Are there any other eligibility requirements?*

Yes! In order to be eligible for this scholarship, you must also:

- Be newly admitted to the Fuller DMFT degree program.
- Maintain a minimum cumulative Fuller GPA of 3.0 to remain eligible

Doctor of Psychology in Clinical Psychology (PsyD)

Who can receive this scholarship?

Students admitted to the PsyD program for the upcoming Fall 2022 Quarter are eligible to receive this scholarship.

Are there any other eligibility requirements?*

Yes! In order to be eligible for this scholarship, you must also:

- Be newly admitted to the Fuller PsyD degree program
- Maintain active participation in a research lab
- Maintain at least half-time enrollment from Fall Spring quarters

Doctor of Philosophy in Clinical Psychology (PhD in Clinical Psychology)

Who can receive this scholarship?

Students admitted to the PhD in Clinical Psychology program for the upcoming Fall 2022 Quarter are eligible to receive this scholarship.

^{*} New DMFT students who enroll in AY22/23 are eligible to receive scholarship support if they apply for and receive the DMFT Scholarship and if they meet and maintain the DMFT Scholarship criteria outlined. New DMFT students may only receive one institutional scholarship or discount from Fuller in a quarter, except in the case when they are also eligible for, apply to, and are awarded an endowed scholarship.

^{*}Scholarship selection is determined by vote of the faculty and is based upon prior academic history, test scores (PsyD), interviews, and recommendation of the department of Clinical Psychology Admissions Committee.

Are there any other eligibility requirements?*

Yes! In order to be eligible for this scholarship, you must also:

- Be newly admitted to the Fuller PhD degree program
- Maintain active participation in a research lab
- Maintain at least half-time enrollment from Fall Spring quarters
